Spiritual Care at University Hospital and MacKellar Centre, Geelong

Privacy laws have changed, and this may leave members of our congregations without Spiritual Care when they have a hospital stay or are in residence or respite.

The Presbytery of Port Phillip West currently provides 2 days per week (Monday & Friday) of spiritual care to the greater Geelong community based at University Hospital, Geelong. Rev Isabel Greenall is in the Placement offering care and support to patients and staff primarily at the hospital but also to those at the Mackellar Centre, as needed.

Historically, the Uniting Church chaplain has been able to access a list of all Uniting Church patients and visit them. However, with recent review of procedures alongside privacy legislation, it is no longer possible to do this. The process now is that a patient will need to ask their nurse or another member of the ward staff for a visit from the Uniting Church chaplain or Spiritual Care team. They will then put in a referral requesting a visit.

Sometimes, family members, congregation members and Ministers may know someone in hospital, who might need some care during their admission. The most important thing is that their permission is obtained before letting Isabel or the Spiritual Care team know. If the patient is not able to give their own consent, it needs to come from their next of kin.
