Theme Ideas from Ministry Matters

The revelation of God's glory intermingles with the glorification of God's followers in today's readings. Not only is Jesus transfigured before the disciples' eyes, they are brought into a new level of understanding of Jesus' greatness and glory. Just as Moses reveals God's instructions by bringing the tablets of the covenant to the Hebrew people, Jesus' transfiguration reveals a new understanding of who Jesus is to his disciples. The letter to the Corinthians pulls these ideas together, reminding us that God's glory has not only been revealed to us in Christ, but is being revealed through us as disciples of Christ.

Being Church in a Liminal Time

Rev Linley Liersch writes in the Port Phillip West Presbytery, Westerly, "For many years now, the church has been living in the Christian Era where the church was at the centre of society. But now the church has been pushed to the edges of society."

We are living in a time of change, a liminal time, a time of in between the old and the new. We notice the old structures breaking down and it is time to rethink how we are church in this changing context.

This Lenten study will consider the book: Being Church in a Liminal Time by Jeffery D. Jones Remembering, Letting go, Resurrecting. "The customary answers about what it means to be and do church and strategies for renewal based on those answers no longer work. This book addresses this reality while maintaining a constant focus on the Christian promise of
