Theme Ideas from Ministry Matters

These readings, on the First Sunday of Lent, invite us to remember who we are and whose we are. No matter the journey we take, God is our faithful companion and guide. As many hymn writers have noted, God is the One who's gotten us this far. The devil tempts Jesus to both forget and reject his heritage, his identity, and his trust in God. But Jesus stands firmly on his heritage, as a child of God and as a member of the Hebrew people. Like Moses before him, Jesus knows that the Holy Spirit, who led him to this wilderness, will also lead him through the wilderness. This theme is echoed throughout the three related readings as well.

Loose Change

Our offering on Sunday for loose change amounted to \$148.85.

Hospice Nepal is a non-profit NGO established in 2000 by two amazing Nepali Doctors. It has a model of free service providing care for patients suffering from life-threatening diseases including, but not only, cancer, with the intention to improve the quality of life for the patient and their families. Physical symptomatic care is given, and psychological and spiritual support is provided by the team, which includes doctors, nurses and other health care professionals. This is called Palliative Care. Currently, there is an 8 bed unit in a hospital where 150-200 patients are looked after each year. About 50% are discharged for ongoing home based care.
