Maundy Thursday is the Thursday before Easter, commemorating significant events in the Christian tradition, particularly the Last Supper of Jesus with his disciples, when he gave them a new commandment to love one another. It is also known for the Washing of the Feet, symbolizing humility and service.

This day marks the institution of the Eucharist, where Jesus shared bread and wine, representing His body and blood. Maundy Thursday is part of Holy Week, leading up to Easter Sunday.

Our Linked Congregations worship for Maundy Thursday will be held next Thursday night at 7.00pm at Drysdale.
