Theme from Ministry Matters

Isaiah, the psalmist, and Luke make clear that if our actions do not embody justice and righteousness, even worshipping the "right way" is spiritually empty and is not pleasing to God. God will not listen to the prayers of those who trample the weak and whose hands are full of blood.

The psalmist adds that our God is a devouring fire, and those who do not repent of their errant ways will be utterly swept away. Still, those who live according to God's precepts will know the glory of salvation in Christ.

In Luke, Jesus tells us not to worry, for it is God's pleasure to give us the kingdom. Still, Jesus warns that we should store up treasures in heaven, not on earth—for where our treasure is, there our hearts will be also.

Caring for God's Creation UCA President renews call for Australia to sign treaty

On 6 and 9 August 2025, the world will commemorate 80 years since the catastrophic atomic bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki. As these significant anniversaries approach, Uniting Church President Rev Charissa Suli has written to Prime Minister Anthony Albanese and Foreign Minister Penny Wong urging the Australian Government to immediately sign and ratify the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons. "For more than four decades, the Uniting Church in Australia has rejected the use, proliferation and threat of nuclear weapons in the strongest possible terms," the President wrote. "These weapons are morally indefensible and fundamentally incompatible with the Gospel of Christ."

"We urge you now to translate commitments into action by immediately signing and ratifying the Treaty, and offering leadership in international disarmament efforts for the sake of the whole creation."


