Renewables overtake coal for the first time

Renewable electricity generation has surpassed coal for the first time, both worldwide and in Australia - marking a powerful step in the global transition away from fossil fuels. A recent report by the energy thinktank Ember has shown that the world generated almost a third more solar power in the first half of 2025 compared to the same period in 2024 largely driven by massive expansions in China and India. Combined with steady wind growth, solar and wind power together met 83 per cent of the global increase in electricity demand, resulting in a small but significant decline in coal and gas use.
