Minister's Musings - Starting the year on an even keel.

There are days when the burdens of life weigh heavily upon one's shoulders.

For me right now, the main priority is attending to my wife's needs as she moves into her second week of radiotherapy in a Melbourne hospital. Then there is worship to prepare and overdue pastoral visits, reports to church councils, and preparation for Lenten studies. Managing my diary has never been more important.

What I have learned over the years is that there is a limit to what can be achieved in a week, in a month, in a year. Having realistic expectations of self, of others, of church, helps us set an even keel to approach the year. When things come unstuck (and they do) there is much room for generosity and grace. And what do we expect of God? Imagining myself as a sail-boat, my keel keeps me steady in the water. I am learning to rest into God's embrace, trusting the Eternal Mystery to hold me and direct me, even when currents and winds are not quite as anticipated. As a church too, together we can trust in the Holy Three-in-One to keep our coracle (boat) of community, not simply 'afloat' but flourishing together held in Holy love. Generosity and grace, I think, are the hallmarks of a thriving community. I believe we do this well!

May the Spirit fill our sails and send us to where we are needed. May Christ Jesus give us the courage to offer the world the best of ourselves. May the Creator God continue to inspire new and creative ways of being God's people in the world.
